Rickman, being first duly sworn, deposes and says; that he is the applicant for permit to appropriate for power purposes, the waters of White River, this County-permit No. 519, dated April 6, 1908; that since said date, he has caused to be surveyed and platted by John Nice, U. S. Mineral Surveyor, the said stream, dam and power sites, wagon roads and weirs constructed; that he has built a substantial road along said stream to enable the transporting of machinery and other supplies to the places where the works are to be constructed:

That he applied for said permit, and is keeping the same alive, in good faith, and not for mere speculative purposes; that on account of financial disappointments he was unable to commence the actual construction of the power plant last summer, and that on account of heavy snows, it would be almost a physical impossibility to commence the same till the Spring of 1910 opens; that because of this unavoidable delay, he will not be able to complete the plant by July 1st., 1910, the date set forth in said permit.

Therefore affiant respectfully requests the Hon. Frank R. Nicholas, State Engineer of the State of Nevada, to extend the time within which the works shall be completed to July 1st., 1911.
