This application is made for power purposes, as hereinafter stated, and this application is, and the uses to which applicant desires to put said waters, will be, subject and subordinate to the rights of the Osceola Gravel Company, its successors and assigns, to use said waters, or any portion thereof, according to its rights as now established, in either or both of its ditches as now constructed. The intention of this applicant is, and the rights which he seeks to acquire are, to use all, or such portions of said waters, during all seasons of the year not actually used by said Osceola Gravel Company, its successors and grantees, and by it or them diverted, in such manner as to make the use thereof by this applicant impracticable.

8. Description of works for diversion:

I. Kind of works (reservoir, dam, ditch, flume, pipes or otherwise) ditch, flumes and pipes. Water to be taken from point of diversion in a ditch and flume to a point on Baker Creek known as the Narrows. There it will be taken up by a pipe line and conveyed to a point as stated above where the power is to be generated.
