This permit is issued with the express provisions that the applicant shall within sixty days commence the work of surveying his works of diversion; that he shall within six months, from the date hereof, file in the office of the State Engineer at Carson City, complete maps, profiles and cross sections of his proposed works, certified to as having been prepared from actual surveys on the ground by a competent engineer or surveyor; and that failure to comply with any of the foregoing provisions will be considered as cause for cancellation hereof.
