APPLICATION FOR CHANGE OF POINT OF DIVERSION.

The undersigned, The Jefferson Gold and Silver Mining Company, and the Jefferson Mining Company, lessee, herewith make application for permission to change the point of diversion of certain waters of Jefferson Creek, Jefferson Mining District, Nye County, State of Nevada, which water is now being diverted, and has been diverted for 23 years last past, from present head of the Kanrohat Mill Ditch (into which all streams hereinafter named converge) to points as follows, to-wit:

A point about three miles up Canyon No. 1, located in a southerly direction from Sawmill Canyon;

A point about three miles up Canyon No. 2, located in a southerly direction from Sawmill Canyon;

A point of about three miles up Canyon No. 3, located in a southerly direction from Sawmill Canyon; (All of said Canyons leading up to the foot of Mount Jefferson)

A point about three miles up Canyon No. 4, known also as Mogul Canyon, leading up towards the Spanish Mountains. All of said waters being returned to the stream at a point about 400 feet below building known as the Jefferson Brewery, in said Jefferson Canyon, the water so diverted to be used for mining and milling purposes upon property of the Jefferson Gold and Silver Mining Company, and at mill now being erected upon same.

This water was diverted and used by Charles J. Kanrohat since 1886, as appears on the Proof of Appropriation as filed herewith.
