REMARKS:

The water sought to be appropriated must be developed to a greater or lesser degree from springs as noted in the foregoing. At the present time the water from the springs, mingled with the water from melting snows, runs down Trough Canyon and passes through my land, but later in the season when water is needed for irrigation, snow has all disappeared and water from springs alone will not run down the canyon. My purpose is to clean and dig out the several springs, constituting the water supply, lead what water I can develop from each spring in this manner to a main ditch to be constructed by me, and then convey it to the point of use. It remains to be seen by means of such development the exact amount of water that can be procured.

Springs are on Sections Nine and Ten, Township 39 North, Range 62 East, M.D.M. These are springs from which water is to be taken.
