THE TRUCKEE RIVER GENERAL  
ELECTRIC COMPANY.

The applicant was granted, under permit No. 1475, approved January 27, 1910, 500 cubic feet per second of the waters of the Truckee River to be diverted at a point near the line between the NW/4 of Section 29, and the N.E/4 of Section 30, T. 19 N; R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M. about 500 feet down the stream from the Fleish power house. These waters were to be used for the generation of electric power and returned to the stream in the NE/4 of Section 16 T. 19 N; R. 18 E.

The applicant desires to change the above point of diversion to the lower end of the present Fleish flume in the SW/4 of Section 29 T. 19 N; R. 18 E. and to convey the water from the said lower end of the present Fleish flume, the whole or a part of the time, over and across the following sections:

SW/4 and NW/4 Section 29, SW/4, SE/4 and NE/4  
Section 20. NW/4 and NE/4 Section 21. NW/4  
NE/4 Section 22. NW/4 Section 23, and SW/4 Sec.  
14, all in T. 19, R. 18 E.

It desires to convey this water by means of the following works: by flume, pipes and tunnel a distance of 1-3/4 miles to a regulating reservoir in the NE/4 of Section 20 and NW/4 of Section 21, T. 19 N; R. 18 E; thence by flume, pipes and tunnel, the water will be carried a distance of approximately two miles to a point on the mountainside southerly of the Washoe Power house, thence by wood and steel pressure pipes down to the present Washoe power house (to be enlarged); thence to be returned to the Truckee River through an enlargement of the tailrace of the present Washoe power house in SW/4 of Section 14; T. 19 N., R. 18 E. in Washoe County, Nevada.

Estimated cost of works - \$750,000.00  
Amount of power to be generated - 9,000 HP.  
Capacity of reservoir - 5,000,000 cu. ft.  
Size of wood stave pipe and tunnels - 7' and 8' diameter  
Size of flume - a proximately- 6' .0 X 10'.0  
Average grade per mile - 2.6'  
Length of ditch - 4 miles.

WHEREFORE, your applicant prays that such change in the point of diversion and point of return, and in the description thereof may be authorized by the Honorable State Engineer, and that said officer shall take such measures respecting the publication and other matters relating thereto as may be required by the statutes in such cases made and provided.
