permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The water to be used must not exceed 3 acre feet per acre for the five months May 1st to October 1st, and 1/2 of one acre foot per acre for each additional month used.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1 1/2 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 8th. 1912.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 8th. 1912.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 8th. 1913.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 8th. 1915.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before November 8th. 1915.
