The undersigned Comet Placer Mining Company

State of Utah, hereby make application for

permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,

under the Laws of Nevada.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water is to be diverted by means of a 3 inch pipe line extending from State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions:

springs to a reservoir which, when land is surveyed, will be located in the NE 1/4 of Sec. 1, T. 32 N., R. 29 E., of M. D. Meridian. From this storage reservoir the water will be diverted directly on to concentration tables or other appliances used in the treatment of ores or gravels, and thence to settling tanks, from which it will be taken and used over again in the treatment of ores or gravels.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November, 5th, 1912.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May, 5th, 1913.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before June, 5th, 1913.
