The undersigned Nevada Land and Live Stock Company, a corporation

State of Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.) June, 1907, incorporated under the laws of Nevada.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the stream system. The right herein granted is for flood water only. Water must not be diverted after July 1st., of any year without first getting permission from the office of the State Engineer. The completed right will be recognized for that amount of land only which has been cleared and ditched in a manner so that the water can be properly controlled for the irrigation of the land. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Ten (10) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 25th. 1915.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 25th. 1915.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 25th. 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 25th. 1919.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before November 25th. 1919.
