hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada; as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

- The source of the proposed appropriation is Deer Creek in Elko County, Nevada. Name of stream, lake, or other source.
- The amount of water applied for is 70 second-feet. One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.
- The water to be used for Irrigation. Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.
- The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 22 in Tp. 45 N.R. 51 E. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

The water herein applied for is to be diverted from the stream by State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits: If water is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. a rock and earth dam fifty feet long and six feet high and carried to two ditches, each approximately 12 feet wide on top, 8 feet wide on bottom and three feet deep and about four and one half miles long. One of said ditches being on the north side of the creek and one on the south side.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

Granted with the condition that no prior rights will be impaired by diversion hereunder.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 28 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 7th. 1912

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 7th. 1912

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 7th. 1914

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 7th. 1916

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before November 7th. 1916
