TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The undersigned Alvaro & John Evans,
of Reno, County of Washoe,
State of Nevada, hereby make application for
permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,
as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and
place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Warm Spring
2. The amount of water applied for is 4.57 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: SW 1/4 Sec. 24, T. 37 N.R. 43 E., M.D.B & M.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 320
(b) Description of land to be irrigated S 1/2 Sec. 28, T. 37
(c) Irrigation will begin about April and end about
October, of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, TRANSPORTATION, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE
FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (d) Power to be developed is horse power.
(e) Works to be located
(f) Point of return of water to stream
(g) Remarks The water now flows over the land to be irrigated,
but no legal diversion has been made. The lands upon which the
water rise are held in private ownership, but the water has not
been legally appropriated.

A small diversion dam is to be constructed, whence the water will be conveyed along the south boundary of Secs. 22 & 23, and the bdy of Sec. 28 to point of use by means of ditch.
