APPLICATION FOR CHANGE OF POINT OF DIVERSION OF WATER ON

CARSON RIVER.

JUN 18 1911

To the State Engineer,

Carson City, Nevada.

Honorable Sir:-

The H. F. Dangberg Land & Live Stock Company, a Corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Nevada, hereby applies for permission to change point of diversion of certain waters of the East Fork of the Carson River, now diverting through the Allerman Ditch, which said ditch diverts waters from the east bank of said East Fork of the Carson River, beginning at a point 990 feet north from the SE corner of Section 23, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B & M., to a ditch known as and called the Buckeye Ditch, which said Buckeye Ditch diverts the waters from the East bank of said River at a point from which the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, T. 12 N., R., 20 E., M.D.B & M. being the $\frac{1}{4}$ section, between sections 14 and 23, bears north 28 degrees and 30 minutes east, 23 chains and 25 links.

The lands for which change of point of diversion is asked for and heretofore served by the Allerman Ditch, and hereafter to be served by the Buckeye Ditch are identical and described as follows:

Comprising all that portion of land lying west of the new line of the Buckeye Ditch, and east of a portion of the Upper Virginia Ditch and County Road, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:- Beginning at a point on the line of the north line fence of the County Road, said roads lying between the land of the H. F. Dangberg Land & Live Stock Company and Fritz Springmeyer, said point being east of the East Fork Schoolhouse, where the new line of the Buckeye Ditch crosses the north line road fence thence along west bank of said ditch to the Gott Reservoir, thence along the west shore line of the said reservoir to a point due east of the nearest point of the Upper Virginia Ditch, to said Gott Reservoir, thence west to said Virginia Ditch, thence along east bank of Ditch to East side fence of the County Road, thence along east side fence of County Road to a point where said road turns east, thence along north side of said County Road to the point of beginning, containing 67 acres more or less, exclusive of the land in the southwest portion of said described tract included within the fence line of the East Fork Schoolhouse grounds, being about one and one-half acres, more or less. This land occupies portions of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10. Also portions of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 11 T. 12 N., R. 20 E. M.D.B & M.

Applicant waives none of its rights under its Allerman Ditch rights other than such rights as will be necessarily changed from the Allerman to Buckeye, and for the acres of land hereinbefore especially set forth.

Wherefore applicant prays to be permitted to change point of diversion from the Allerman Ditch to the Buckeye Ditch, to serve and irrigate the lands above described.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit for a change in the point of diversion of certain waters of the East Carson River from the Allerman Ditch to the Buckeye Ditch is made with the understanding that the stipulation dated April 24, 1917, governs insofar as the protest is concerned and that the Wheeler Ditch and Buckeye Ditch shall be considered, for the purposes herein, as one and the same.

The State reserves the right to regulate the use of water under the proposed change at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed sixty-seven one hundredths (0.67) of a foot cubic foot per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 3, 1917.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 3, 1917.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 3, 1918.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 3, 1918.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before December 3, 1918.
