If water is to be water led through a 2 inch pipe line 1200 feet long to the North stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. Spring intake of the Holt Creek Pipe Line, and thence to Copper Flat.
