APPLICATION FOR PERMISSION TO CHANGE THE POINT OF DIVERSION  
AND PLACE OF USE OF WATER ALREADY APPROPRIATED.

September 5th, 1911.

To the Honorable State Engineer of the State of Nevada,  
Carson City, Nevada.

Notice is hereby given that John G. Taylor, of Lovelock, Nevada, and J. Sheehan of Winnemucca, Nevada, acting through the said John G. Taylor, his attorney in fact, whose post office address is Lovelock, Humboldt County, State of Nevada, hereby makes application to the State Engineer for permission to change the place of diversion of the waters of the Humboldt River in said Humboldt County, which have been heretofore appropriated and used by them, as herein after stated, and in that behalf shows:-

First, That your applicants and their predecessors in interest have for over forty-nine years last past beneficially used and appropriated the waters of the said Humboldt River and during all of said period have, by means of dams and ditches, conveyed said waters upon lands occupied, possessed and cultivated by them, and there use the same for the purpose of irrigation of the said lands, and for raising crops of hay and other farm products thereon.

Second, That the lands so possessed, cultivated and irrigated by them are situate along and near the Humboldt River and are in Sections 18, 19, 20, 21, 28, 33, 34, 29 in Township 36, N.R. 40 E., M.D. B & M., and Sections 13 and 14 Township 36 N.R. 39 E., M.D. B & M., comprising 1900 acres, and the point of diversion at which said waters have been so diverted by said dam and ditch is situate on the said Humboldt River at a point in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 25, T. 36 N.R. 40 E., M.D. B & M.

Third, That the use of said waters by applicants and their predecessors have during all of said period of over forty-nine years been open, notorious, under claim of right, adversely to all the world, and prior to all persons, and that claimants now has and owns the exclusive prior rights to the use of all of the waters heretofore conveyed in said ditch.

Fourth, That applicants desire to change their place of diversion of the waters of said Humboldt River, and to divert said water at a point in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 35, T. 36, N.R. 40 E., M. D. B & M., and by means of a dam and ditch to convey said waters of the said river across Sec. 35, 34, 33, 32, 29, 30 and 19 T. 36 N.R. 40 E. and Sec. 24, T. 36 N.R. 39 E., M.D. B & M., to the following described lands, which it is now proposed to irrigate:- Parts of Sections 18, 19, 20, 29 and 30, T. 36 N.R. 40 E., and Sections 13, 14 and 24 T. 36 N.R. 39 E., M.D. B & M., comprising 1900 acres, and to make use of all the waters heretofore appropriated in the irrigation of said lands.

The estimated time required to construct the said works is eighteen months, and the estimated cost of said works is \$30,000.00. A map of the lands heretofore irrigated, and of the present ditch, and a map of the proposed ditch, and the lands to be irrigated therefrom is attached hereto and made a part of this application.

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This application to change the point of diversion and place of use is granted with the following limitations and conditions:

That the amount of water diverted at the new diversion shall not exceed one and 45/100 cubic feet per second during the irrigating season commencing April 1st and ending October 1st of each year. The State reserves the right to regulate the diversion of such water at all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One and 45/100 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 15, 1915. Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 15, 1915. Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 1, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 27, 1917.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before November 27, 1917.
