1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Ash Canyon

2. The amount of water applied for is 8 1/2 second-feet.
One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation & Domestic purposes.
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 15 N.R. 19 E., M.D.B & M.
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.
