DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

The waters will be diverted from the stream by a small earth and rock dam, thence by ditch to the point of use. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the local subdivisions.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source, and subject to rights on the stream of which Kolcheck Spring is a tributary.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed --0.25-- cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 21st, 1914.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 21st, 1914.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 21st, 1915.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 21st, 1916.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before November 21st, 1916.
