permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,

December 7th, 1906, and having a place  
of business at Carlin, Nevada.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Humboldt River

One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.
3. The water to be used for producing ice for use in cars, etc.

point: North 52° 53' W., 2102 feet from the SE corner of Section

of each year, for the purpose of producing ice for icing cars  
and for domestic and other ordinary uses of ice. Reservoir to  
be filled to a depth of not over four feet and water to be  
returned to river.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

This water to be diverted from the Humboldt river at the point designated and on the north bank of the river by means of a pump which will elevate the water 18 feet to a flume 3 feet wide by 2 feet high, running thence N. 47° 25' W. 1000 feet, then into two 10" pipes continuing on same course a distance of 210 feet, which pipes discharge into the existing ice pond belonging to applicant, located in the SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of SW 1/4, and NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 26, T. 33 N.R. 52 E.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the Humboldt River system. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of water under this permit. The water must be returned to the stream as outlined in the application under which this grant is made.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Twelve (12) cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a total of 150 acre-feet per season.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 10, 1915.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 10, 1915.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 10, 1915.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 10, 1916.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before March 10, 1916.
