This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby <sup>DENY</sup> ~~grant~~ the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This application is DENIED on the grounds, that there is not sufficient un-appropriated water in Barley Creek for use in direct irrigation and for a period long enough to mature crops.

That the applicant herein has avested right to the use of the water on portions of the lands to be irrigated, as named in the application. That the application if granted would be detrimental to the public welfare.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed \_\_\_\_\_ cubic feet per second.
