This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights for stock watering purposes on this source. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Three (3.0) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 13, 1915.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before January 13, 1916.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 13, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 13, 1920.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before November 13, 1920.
