

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The undersigned John H. Wolf of Wells, County of Elko State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Sun Creek, Elko County, Nevada, the water applied for being the unappropriated flood waters of said stream.
2. The amount of water applied for is 2 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: South-east quarter of North-east quarter of Section 28, Township 44 North, Range 60 East, M.D.B & M.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 320
(b) Description of land to be irrigated South half of the North east quarter of Section twenty-eight; the south half of the north-west quarter, the north half of the south-west quarter, the south-west quarter of the north-east quarter and the north west quarter of the south-east quarter of Section twenty-seven, Township 44, North, Range 60 East, M.D.B & M.
(c) Irrigation will begin about 1st of April and end about June 15th, of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, TRANSPORTATION, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (d) Power to be developed is horse power.
(e) Works to be located
(f) Point of return of water to stream
(g) Remarks

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

An earth and stone dam in the stream and a ditch conveying the water so appropriated upon the land.

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is granted subject to all prior rights on the source and on the stream system of which Sun Creek is a part. It is also subject to regulation at all times by the State Engineer, to fully protect the prior rights.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Two (2) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 21st, 1913.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 21st, 1913.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Dec. 21st, 1913.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 21st, 1916.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before July 21st, 1916.
