State of Idaho, hereby make an application for

permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Poison Creek, Name of stream, lake, or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 6.40 second-feet. One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: In Unsurveyed Twp. 47 North, Rng. 59 East, Mt. Diablo Mer., the same being 16,230 ft. west of the Nw cor of Twp. 47 North, Rng. 60 East, Mt. Diablo Meridian.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(a) Number of acres to be irrigated is Six hundred and forty acres.

(b) Description of land to be irrigated Unsurveyed lands in Twp. 16 South, Rng. 10 East, Boise Mer. Owyhee County, Idaho. Describe by legal subdivision, or if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated and a description provided in accordance with special instruction from the State Engineer when application is returned for correction.

(c) Irrigation will begin about June 1st, and end about October 1st, of each year. Month.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, TRANSPORTATION, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(d) Power to be developed is horse power.

(e) Works to be located Give 40-acre subdivision on which works will be located, or locate by course and distance to a section corner.

(f) Point of return of water to stream Describe in same manner as point of diversion.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

The water applied for is to be stored in a small reservoir, made State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water by building a dam across Poison Creek, and conducted to the lands is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions, by small ditches, the main one of which is 3 ft., wide on the bottom and banks 2 ft., high. It is 1 1/2 miles in length and beings distribution as soon as it leaves the reservoir. The Reservoir is on unsurveyed land and lies south of the Dam.

It is distinctly understood that the State Engineer will grant a later application for the use of this water within the State of Nevada, should an application be made to appropriate it in the above manner.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Six & 4/10 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30th, 1913.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 30th, 1913.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 30th, 1914.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 30th, 1917.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before November 30th, 1917.
