It is distinctly understood that this permit to

appropriate water makes no grant for rights of

way necessary to complete the works of diversion

or use of water.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One twentieth cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 10-1914.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 10-1914.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 10-1914.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 10-1915.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before November 10-1915.
