permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,
as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is the springs and waters of Limerick Canyon
2. The amount of water applied for is Two second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Domestic use and irrigation
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: above a point in the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 12, T.
28 N.R. 33 E., and S. 34° 07' E. 672.9' from NW Cor. of same.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is eighty, or thereby
(b) Description of land to be irrigated Lands along bottom of
Limerick Canyon in the N 1/2 of the NE 1/4 and NW 1/4 of Sec. 12, T.

- (c) Irrigation will begin about February and end about
October, of each year.

lower spring in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 12, T. 28 N.R. 33 E.,
at a point S. 46° 27' W 1225' from, the NE Cor. of the NW 1/4 of
Sec. 12, T. 28 N.R. 33 E. and thence to fields in NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of
Sec. 12, T. 28 N.R. 33 E.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water to be developed further by open cuts in bottom of Canyon, State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water and diverted by dam, and conveyed in ditches or pipes. is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 1st. 1914.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before May 1st. 1914.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1st. 1914.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 1st. 1916.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before May 1st. 1916.
