This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to the existing rights on the source. The lands to be irrigated are identical with the lands named in applications No. 2623, 2625 and 2626 therefore this permit for 1.2 cubic feet of water per second is meant to apply to all of the permits, the lands being the same.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One & 2/10 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 27th, 1914.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 27th, 1914.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 27th, 1915.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 27-1917.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before October 27-1917.
