This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The water herein granted must be returned to the stream unpolluted at the point designated in the application. The permit is issued subject to prior rights.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Two (2) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 30th, 1914.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 30th, 1914.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 30th, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before Oct. 30th, 1916.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before Nov. 30th, 1916.
