This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: this permit is granted subject to prior rights on the source and with the condition that irrigation of the land shall not begin before April 1st. or be extended beyond October 1st. of each year.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.16 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 1st, 1914.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before May 1st, 1914.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1st, 1914.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 1st, 1914.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 1st, 1914.

The undersigned, E. Bokelmann, of Gardnerville, County of Douglas, State of Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to change the point of diversion of waters heretofore appropriated and beneficially used.

The source of the proposed change in the point of diversion is the East Fork of Carson River.

The amount of land irrigated is 16 acres and the same is situated in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 4, and the SW cor of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 4, T. 12 N.R. 20 E., M.D.B & M.

The present point of diversion is in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 4, T. 12 N.R. 20 E., through the Hussman Company Ditch.

The water is to be pumped direct from the stream in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 4, T. 12 N.R. 20 E., M.D.B & M.

The description of the proposed works is as follows-- pump, short pipe line and flume.

Estimated cost of works--400.00 dollars.

Estimated time required to construct works--two months.

Irrigation will begin about April 1st and end about October 1st of each year.
