DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

The water will be diverted by a small rock and earth dam into a State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water ditch 3 feet wide on the bottom, two feet deep on an average, with is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. a grade of four feet to the mile.

- 5. Estimated cost of works One thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00)
6. Estimated time required to construct works One year.
7. Remarks It will require four years to place the water to a beneficial use on the lands to be irrigated.

This permit is granted subject to existing rights.

The State Engineer reserves the right to regulate the use of water herein granted to insure protection to all users on the source.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Three & 1/2 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 15-1914.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 15-1914.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 15---1914.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 15-1917

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before October 15-1917.
