permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Bostwick Creek and all tributaries.
2. The amount of water applied for is three (3) second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: Within the NE 1/4 - NW 1/4 Sec. 31 Tp. 19 N.R. 62 E. M.D.B & M.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is granted subject to all prior rights on the source. The use of water herein granted is subject to regulation by the State Engineer at all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Three (3) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 20th, 1914.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 20th, 1914.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 20th, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 20th, 1918.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before November 20-1918.
