permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Cold Springs

2. The amount of water applied for is 3 second-feet.
One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 11 N.R. 62 E., M.D.B & M.

If water of the NW 1/4 Sec. 33 T. 11 N.R. 62 E., M.D.B & M. is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is granted subject to all prior rights on the source or stream system of which it is a part.

The regulation of the water granted herein is reserved to the state when such becomes necessary by reason of conflict or otherwise.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One & 6/10 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 7th, 1914.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 7th, 1914.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 7th, 1915.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 7th, 1919.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before November 7th, 1919.
