APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source and the amount of the appropriation is limited to one and six-tenths cubic feet of water per second for 160 acres of land. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any time. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One & 6/10 cubic feet per second. (1.6)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 24, 1916.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before May 24, 1916.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 24, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 24, 1920.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before November 24, 1920.
