The undersigned H.L. McIntyre and J.F. Weaver
of Eagleville, County of Modoc, State of California, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is BUFFALO CREEK AND TRIBUTARIES (Floodwaters)
2. The amount of water applied for is Fifty (50) second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic Purposes
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NE 1/4 of NE 1/4, Sec. 25 T. 32 N.R. 19 E., M.D.B & M.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is Five Thousand (5000) Acres.
(b) Description of land to be irrigated Sections and Portions of Sec. 19, 20, 21, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33 and 34 T. 32 N.R. 20 E., and N 1/2, Sec. 4, Sec. 5 and 6 T. 31 N.R. 20 E., M.D.B & M.
(c) Irrigation will begin about February 1st and end about September 1st, of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, TRANSPORTATION, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (d) Power to be developed is horse power.
(e) Works to be located
(f) Point of return of water to stream Not returned.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water will be diverted by means of dams, ditches and laterals.

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water

is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

- 5. Estimated cost of works Thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00)
- 6. Estimated time required to construct works Four years.
- 7. Remarks It will require six years to place the water to a beneficial use on the lands to be irrigated.
