The undersigned Elko Water and Light Corporation doing
of business at Elko, County of Elko, State of Nevada, hereby make s application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.) Incorporated June 1906, under the laws of the State of Nevada.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Undeveloped springs flowing only part of the year, situated at head of Kittridge Creek.
2. The amount of water applied for is One second-foot.
3. The water to be used for Municipal & domestic purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: Boggs and springs situated on E 1/2 of NW 1/4 and N 1/2 of SW 1/4 section 15, T. 35 N.R. 55 E., M.D.B & M., to be developed and led by pipe line to a common confluence in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 15, T. 35 N.R. 55 East; the springs being tributary to the point of common juncture.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

should be so stated and a description provided in accordance with special instruction from the State Engineer when application is returned for correction.

- (c) Irrigation will begin about and end about of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, TRANSPORTATION, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (d) Power to be developed is horse power.
(e) Works to be located Tunnels-etc. to be located on the E 1/2 NW 1/4 and N 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 15, T. 35 N.R. 55 E., M.D.B & M.

- (f) Point of return of water to stream not to be returned.

(g) Remarks The water applied for is to be developed by means of tunnels and cuts or by other means as found best, and conveyed to the town of Elko for domestic purposes.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Tunnels, cuts or other works will be constructed to develop the State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water water, whence it will be conducted to the point of common confluence named in question No. 4, by means of pipe lines about 3 ins in diameter, whence it will be conducted to the present works and pipe lines constructed under permit No. 1361, for transmission to the Elko Distributing system. The approximate number of persons to be served is 1500.

- 5. Estimated cost of works \$5000.00
6. Estimated time required to construct works 2 years.
7. Remarks Work could not commence until May 1st, 1914 on account of weather.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the stream system of which this source is a tributary, thus permitting the development of the springs herewith applied for. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One (1.0) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 28, 1917.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 28, 1917.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 28, 1919.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 28, 1920.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with the State Engineer on or before July 28, 1920.
