The undersigned Jas S. Coleman of Tonopah, and J.A. Bradford
of Ash Meadows, County of Nye, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is An underground stream known as Devils Hole
2. The amount of water applied for is 18 8/10 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: From Devils Hole, situated in SoW 1/4, SoE 1/4 Sec. 36, T. 17 S.R. 51 E., M.D.B M., through a tunnel driven from a point starting on SW 1/4-NE 1/4 S.1, T. 18 S.R. 51 E., driven direct to Devils Hole.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is Eighteen Hundred & 80
(b) Description of land to be irrigated SE 1/4 Sec. 7, SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 Sec. 7, W 1/2 Sec. 8, E 1/2 Sec. 18, W 1/2 Sec. 17, NE 1/4 of Sec. 19, N 1/2 of Sec. 19, W 1/2 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 20, NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 20, NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 20, (All the above in T. 18, S.R. 51 E.) (NE 1/4 Sec. 12, S 1/2 of SE 1/4 Sec. 1, NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 Sec. 1, SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 Sec. 1, situated in T. 18 S.R. 50 E., M.D.B & M.)
(c) Irrigation will begin about March 1st and end about August 31st, of each year.

Works consists of tunnel and ditches.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is granted subject to any vested rights there may be on the source of which this office has no record.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 18.8 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Sept. 1st., 1914.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before Oct. 1st., 1914.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Sept. 1st., 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before Sept. 1st., 1920.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with ~~the~~ State Engineer on or before Oct. 1st., 1920
