permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,
as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and
place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is from three
small streams about 12 miles Easterly from NE Cor. Sec. 25, T. 18
N.R. 45 E.
2. The amount of water applied for is 6 cu ft per second-foot.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: on 160 A unsurveyed land described as above 69080, 69570
and 73850 ft., respectively, Easterly from NE Cor., Sec. 25, T.
18 N.R. 45 E., The main point of diversion lies 69570 ft., east-
erly from above section corner.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is Sixty
(b) Description of land to be irrigated unsurveyed land locat-
ed as above stated.
(c) Irrigation will begin about April and end about
July or Aug. of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, TRANSPORTATION, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE
FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (d) Power to be developed is horse power.
(e) Works to be located
(f) Point of return of water to stream Not to be returned as
irrigation will consume all.
(g) Remarks If these 3 streams flowed to the level of the
valley, they would reach a common confluence.
