The undersigned South Nevada Land & Development Company,

State of Nevada, hereby makes application for
permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,
as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground waters
to be brought to the surface by means of artesian or pumping wells.
2. The amount of water applied for is 7.2 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: S 1/2 of NW 1/4 and along West line of SW 1/4 of Sec. 31, T. 20 S. R.
60 E., M. D. B. & M. the exact loci of the wells not being determined
at the present time, the same depending upon development.
