APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source including the sources of which this stream is a tributary. The use of water is subject to regulation by the state at all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Four tenths cubic feet per second. (4/10)- One hundred and twenty acre feet per annum may be used on the land in lieu of the 4/10 C.F.S. Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 9th. 1915.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 9th. 1915. Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 9th. 1915.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 9th. 1918. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 9, 1918.
