Brush, rock and log-crib diversion dam, 300 ft. in length and three ft. in height, with approximate width of 8 ft; lumber and flume headgate approximately 20 ft in width and 6 ft in height; 5 miles of open ditch with slope of one to three. 20 ft in width and ten ft fall to the mile.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. The water herein granted is for power purposes only and must be returned to the stream unpolluted in quality. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. The amount of power to be developed under this permit is limited to 100 horse power. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Fifty (50) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 27, 1916. Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before May 27, 1916. Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 27, 1919. Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 27, 1920. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before May 27, 1920.
