The office assumes from this application that the waters applied for are not percolating, and therefore come within the jurisdiction of the office of the State Engineer.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One (1) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 1st, 1915.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 1st, 1915.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 1st, 1915.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

November 1st, 1919. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before December 1st, 1919.
