This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. The state reserves the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Eight tenths cubic feet per second (.8) or 240 acre-feet per annum.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 20th, 1915.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 20th, 1915.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 20th, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 20, 1919. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 20, 1919.
