The undersigned C. Stevens, B.G. Johnson, Thos. Defenbaugh

State of Nevada, hereby make application for
permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,
as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and
place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Developed spring located as shown on map attached hereto.
2. The amount of water applied for is one half of one second-foot.
3. The water to be used for Domestic purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: On surveyed land in S 1/2 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 33, Town 46 N. Range 39 East, M.D.B & M., and being 1175 easterly from the Northeast corner of Main Street and National Ave., as shown on the recorded surveyed plat of the Town of National.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source.

In granting this permit it is assumed that the water from the spring is not entirely developed and therefore comes within the jurisdiction of the office of the State Engineer.

The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One tenth cubic feet per second. (0.1)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 19, 1916.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 19, 1916.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 19, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 19, 1917. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 19, 1917.


