The undersigned J.G. Ford, Robert O'Neal and Jas. H. Ford, of Tonopah, County of Nye, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of Spanish Creek, also known as Perry Aiken Creek, as applied for under application No. 2955 as hereinafter shown.

1. The source of the water supply of the proposed change is Spanish Creek, also known as Perry Aiken Creek.
2. The amount of water applied for to be changed is 5.78 cubic feet per second.
3. The water is to be used for irrigation and domestic purposes.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 27, T. 3 S.R. 35 E., M.D.B & M. Course N. 90° 45' W., 2620.4 feet from SE Cor. Sec. 27 T. 3 S.R. 35 E., M.D. B & M.
5. The point of diversion heretofore under application No. 2955 is as follows: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 21 T. 3 S.R. 35 E., Tie from NW Cor. Sec. 23, T. 3 S.R. 35 E., M.D.B & M., to point of stream divergence. Course S. 63° 25' W., Distance 7995 ft.
