

AMENDED APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

of Ely, County of White Pine, State of Nevada, hereby make s application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Nigger Creek, Name of stream, lake, or other source.
2. The amount of water applied for is 1.6 second-feet. One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation & Domestic Purposes. Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: On unsurveyed land, 1-1/2 mile east of the SE Cor. of the Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land it should be so stated. N 1/2 of the SW 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 17 N.R. 67 E.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 160
(b) Description of land to be irrigated N 1/2 SW 1/4 and the S 1/2 NW 1/4 - Sec. 35, T. 17 N.R. 67 E. Describe by legal subdivision, or if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated and a description provided in accordance with special instruction from the State Engineer when application is returned for correction.

- (c) Irrigation will begin about January and end about December, of each year. Month.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source and particularly subject to the right of John Yelland for water for 66.63 acres of land as shown by Certificates Nos. 31, 32, and 33, Book 2, issued under proof of appropriation No. 01080. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One & 6/10 cubic feet per second. (1.6)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 1, 1915.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before January 1, 1916.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 14, 1919. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 14, 1919.
