

State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Blasingame Creek

Name of stream, lake, or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 2.4 second-feet.

One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.

3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic purposes.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the stream system of which this source is a tributary. It is specifically understood that by granting this application, the State Engineer does not pass on the value or status of any vested claims except that there is water at certain times available for this right. It is recognized by the State Engineer that a large part of the supply of this source is merely waste water from ranches above. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at all times. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Two & 4/10 cubic feet per second. (2.4)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 29, 1916.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 29, 1916.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 29, 1917.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 29, 1921.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 29, 1921
