permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,

subject to the permits issued Henry Anderson to the flood and snow
waters from Peavine Mtn. the point of diversion of said Anderson being
in Marshall Canyon in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17, T. 20 N.R. 19 E., M.D.M.
2. The amount of water applied for is 640 acre second-feet.
One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source.

A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 640 acre cubic feet per second. annum for storage, or 600 acre feet per annum for direct irrigation.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 26, 1915.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before January 26, 1916.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 26, 1919.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 26, 1920. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 26, 1920.
