State of Nevada, hereby make application for
permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,
as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and
place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Lower Lake Spring.
2. The amount of water applied for is 2 1/2 second-feet.
3. The water to be used for Stock and Irrigation.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: is S. 42° 10' E., 4196 ft., from the SE Corner Sec. 33, T.
8 S.R. 61 E., M.D.B & M.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 160
(b) Description of land to be irrigated Unsurveyed, (Approximately) SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4, SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 Sec. 3 and NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 9 S.R. 61 E., M.D.B & M.

- (c) Irrigation will begin about April 1 and end about November 1, of each year.

IF WATER IS TO BE USED FOR POWER, MINING, TRANSPORTATION, OR OTHER USE, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (d) Power to be developed is horse power.
(e) Works to be located

~~A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.~~

~~The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One & 6/10 cubic feet per second. (1.6)~~

~~Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 14, 1916.~~

~~Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before May 14, 1916.~~

~~Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 14, 1918.~~

~~Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 14, 1920. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 14, 1920.~~
