permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada,
as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation give date and
place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Rebel Creek
Name of stream, lake, or other source.
2. The amount of water applied for is 6.2 second-feet.
One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic.
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following
point: In the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 10, T. 43 N. R. 37 E., M.D.M.
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 640.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water is to be diverted from Rebel Creek by means of a small dam thence in ditches to land described. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water is to be stored in reservoirs it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions.

- 5. Estimated cost of works \$15000 to prepare land for irrigation and for ditches.
6. Estimated time required to construct works 10 years.
7. Remarks I want right to surplus waters of Rebel Creek, in excess of the F.P. Snapp ranch and the Ellison Ranching Co's rights.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source and is for flood and surplus water only. It is expressly understood and made a condition of this permit that a suitable headgate, capable of being locked, will be installed at or near the point of diversion to insure the proper regulation of the water herein granted and that a weir will be constructed to facilitate the measurement of such water. It is further understood that diversion by the applicant must cease immediately upon advice from the State Engineer that a shortage of water exists in the source. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Six and 2/10 cubic feet per second. (6.2)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 15, 1916.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before October 15, 1916.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 15, 1919.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 15, 1923.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 15, 1923.
