This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source and particularly subject to any right held by Wilson Brothers by virtue of Certificate No. 15, Book 3, Page 15, issued under permit No. 1501. A standard headgate and weir must be installed at or near the point of diversion to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at all times. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One & 6/10 cubic feet per second. (1.6)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 20, 1915.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before October 20, 1915.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 20, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 26, 1919. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before September 26, 1919
