The undersigned, Preston Irrigation Company of Preston, White Pine County, Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to change the point of diversion and the place of use of waters heretofore applied for under Application No. 1860, filed in the office of the State Engineer of the State of Nevada on October 29, 1910, upon which application a permit was issued to the Assignor of this applicant for the use of 25 cubic feet of water per second, which said permit is dated the 2nd day of October, 1911, and recorded in Book J, page 1860, Applications for permit, in the State Engineer's office.

The point of diversion named in the application and permit No. 1860, is given as follows: In the natural channel of said springs in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 2, T. 12 N.R. 61 E., M.D.B and M.

The source named in Application No. 1860 is Preston Springs.

The land named to be irrigated in Application No. 1860 is a portion of Sections 19 and 30, T. 12 N.R. 61 E., M.D.B and M.

That applicant desires to change the point of diversion of said water granted to its Assignor under the terms of Permit No. 1860 and to use the same upon certain other portions of land for the purpose of irrigation as well as upon the land to be irrigated as described in Application No. 1860, such point of diversion to be made in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 2, T. 12 N.R. 61 E., M.D.B and M., water to be diverted from natural channel of springs by a dam and conveyed thence by a ditch to a reservoir located in Sec. 36, T. 13 N.R. 61 E., M.D.B and M., unsurveyed, and conveyed to the lands hereinafter described, through ditches diverting at the reservoir dam.

The amount of water hereby applied for to be used upon such change in the point of diversion is twenty-five (25) cubic feet per second, which amount is to be used for irrigation and domestic purposes upon the following lands.

A portion of Sections 18, 19, 30 and 31, T. 12 N.R. 62 E., and a portion of Sections 12, 13, 24 and 25, T. 12 N.R. 61 E., M.D.B and M.

Water will not be returned to stream.

Estimated cost of proposed works: - \$8000.00

Estimated time required to construct works: Two (2) Years.

Remarks: - This application is made for the purpose of changing the point of diversion from the point designated in Permit No. 1860 to the point of diversion given herein, without surrendering any of the rights and privileges granted by Permit No. 1860.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights, and particularly subject to the rights of the Adams-McGill Company, from the White River System as shown by the certificates issued thereon. The amount of water granted is limited to the capacity of the reservoir as shown by the survey, to-wit: 283.29 acre feet. A definite description of the land actually irrigated by virtue of this permit must be filed with the proof of beneficial use hereunder.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Two Hundred Eighty-Three and Twenty-Nine One-Hundredths (283.29) acre feet per annum.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 30, 1916.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 30, 1916.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 30, 1918.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 30, 1920.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before June 30, 1920.
