This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source and particularly subject to the right of John Jory as granted in Certificates Numbers 214, 215 and 216, Book 2, issued under proof of appropriation No. 01263, and to the right of H. O. Christensen as granted in Certificate No. 162, Book 3, issued under permit No. 1846.

This grant is for flood and surplus water only and is subject to regulation by the State at all times in order to insure the proper distribution of the water.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed One (1.0) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 30, 1915.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 30, 1915.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 30, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 30, 1918. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before May 30, 1918.
