APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the stream system of which this source may be tributary. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed Eight (8) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 25, 1915.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 25, 1915.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 25, 1916.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 25, 1921. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before December 25, 1921.
